My dream has been that our men would find value in this shared time together and that some would rise up to lead this effort in creating more opportunities together. Our prayers were answered when Warren Sperry, Bill Schwarz, and Jacob Decker stepped up to further this ministry.

Our 3rd volunteer mowing season is well underway. We've been blessed by volunteers from the congregation and from Roe Center AA who have been working as teams of 3, serving once per month, to fulfill our mowing needs.
